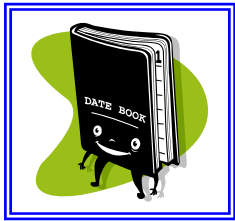

Sunney Sagoo-re-elected as Committee member representing local businesses in the High Road.

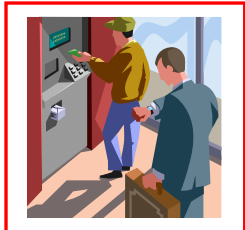
We were sorry to see that the turnout at the AGM was really poor as only 12 members turned up at the meeting

## The latest Crime Report from your Safer Neighbourhoods Team

**Burglary:** There is currently a Burglary problem in the Met, and at present in Church End, Burglary is up 19% on last year. Burglary seems in the main to be occurring in "The Triangle" and in the part of the ward next to the tube line from Broadmead Road down towards St. Albans Road.

**Motor Vehicle Crime:** Motor vehicle is currently a problem in "The Triangle" area of the Ward. Motor Vehicle crime has risen 35% on last year. Suspects are paying particular attention to Theft of Number Plates and Theft of Ford Fiesta parts. We have been actively patrolling "The Triangle" in effort to disrupt offenders and prevent offences occurring. Theft of Number Plates relates to a higher proportion of the property stolen from vehicles.

We conducted a NIK UR REG day on 2<sup>nd</sup> August at Woodford Police Station and we fitted a total of 14 cars with the Tamper Proof Screws and gave Crime Prevention advice to those who attended. We are looking to deliver Crime Prevention to the roads in "The Triangle" area which seem to be affected the most and offer the Tamper Proof Screws as prevention.

**George Lane and High Road:** Theft from Shops (Shoplifting) is up by 48% on last year. This is mainly due to encouraging the retailers to report more incidents than have previously been reported. We are working with the retailers in a number of areas in an effort to prevent offences happening and target offenders.

ATM (Automatic Telling Machines) Theft offences are occurring around most of the ATM's in George Lane and the High Road and groups of suspects are working together to trick the victim to give them their pin number. We are monitoring ATM Thefts, which seem to have stopped, or at least not being reported to Police in such high volumes since May, and we will be liaising with the managers of the branches where the ATM's are located to site further Crime Prevention posters.
